INDICTMENT

The Grand Jurors for the State of Maryland for Baltimore County charge:

COUNT ONE

(CONSPIRACY – CARJACKING RING)

The Jurors of the State of Maryland for the body of Baltimore County, do on their oath present that, beginning in September 2017 through the present day, in Baltimore County and the City of Baltimore, the Defendant, Daquan JOHNSON, along with others known and unknown to the Jurors, did knowingly, intentionally, and unlawfully combine, conspire, confederate, and agree to form an Enterprise whose objective was to take possession of multiple motor vehicles and assorted personal property of different owners, accomplishing this objective by criminal means including acts of violence, unlawful use of weapons, and theft in violation of the common law of Maryland against the peace, government, and dignity of the State.

Background

1. The members of the Enterprise are a group of associates, many of whom hail from the same section of the City of Baltimore. Two of the members, Moya PITTMAN and Dalante GRAHAM, are half-brothers.

2. Members of the Enterprise not only socialize with each other and many of the same individuals in and around the city of Baltimore, but also are friends with each other and many of the same individuals on social media, particularly Facebook, which they frequently use to communicate with each other.

3. The members of the Enterprise pride themselves on “draggin” or “cuttin,” which is slang for doing as they feel without concern for repercussions.

Manner, Means, and Methods of the Conspiracy

4. Members and associates of the Enterprise utilized weapons, such as pellet guns, knives, and handguns in order to commit carjackings and auto thefts.

5. Members and associates of the Enterprise utilized unnecessary violence, often continuing to assault the victim after the Members or associates had control of the victim's vehicle.

6. Members and associates of the Enterprise would intentionally cause superficial vehicle accidents with their victims on the streets of Baltimore County and the City of Baltimore. Then, while feigning a normal exchange of information, the Members would attack the victim and drive away in both the victim's vehicle and the striking vehicle.

7. Members and associates of the Enterprise often targeted victims as they parked, and sometimes even as the victims were walking to or from their homes.

8. Members and associates victimized the same victims more than once. Specifically, the Members would use stolen keys to other vehicles that they obtained during an initial carjacking or theft to go and steal the other vehicles operated by the stolen keys.

9. Members and associates of the Enterprise often documented themselves "joyriding" in the stolen vehicles, posting videos and photos on their social media accounts.

10. Members and associates of the Enterprise wore key fobs on their belts taken from their victims as "trophies" to demonstrate the cars that they had stolen.

Overt Acts in Furtherance of the Conspiracy

11. In furtherance of the conspiracy and to achieve the objectives thereof, Dalante GRAHAM, Tyheim GRAY, Daquan JOHNSON, Travon WILLIAMSTON, and others known and unknown, (hereinafter "the DEFENDANTS"), performed and caused to be performed the following acts, among others, in and throughout Maryland, including in Baltimore City and Baltimore County, and elsewhere:

12. On September 13, 2017, at or near 2455 Forest Green Rd. Baltimore County, Maryland, the Enterprise, including, among others, Dalante GRAHAM and Tyheim GRAY stole [REDACTED] black 2014 Cadillac SRX.

13. On October 9, 2017, in the 5200 block of Gwynn Oak Avenue, Baltimore, Maryland, the Enterprise carjacked [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] was struck in the back of head before the DEFENDANTS took his silver 2005 Honda Accord, wallet, and cellular phone. [REDACTED] suffered injuries to his head, mouth, nose, and chin.

14. On October 27, 2017, at or near 2701 Jeremy Court, Baltimore, Maryland, the Enterprise, including, among others, Moya PITTMAN, carjacked [REDACTED] using a knife.

██████████ was assaulted before the DEFENDANTS took his black 2015 Honda Accord, laptop, and cellular phone. ██████████ suffered injuries to his face and chin.

15. On October 28, 2017, Daquan JOHNSON posted a Facebook video depicting himself driving ██████████ Honda.

16. On October 28, 2017, in the 4400 block of Roland Avenue, Baltimore, Maryland, the Enterprise carjacked ██████████. ██████████ was struck several times in the face before the DEFENDANTS took his burgundy 2017 Honda Accord, wallet, and cellular phone ██████████. ██████████ suffered injuries to his face and eye.

17. On November 6, 2017, in the 2600 block of Guilford Avenue, Baltimore, Maryland, the Enterprise, including, among others, Daquan JOHNSON and Trayvon WILLIAMSTON carjacked ██████████. ██████████ was chased and pushed to the ground as she tried to run away before the DEFENDANTS took her silver 2015 Honda Accord, wallet, and car keys. ██████████ suffered injuries to her hands.

18. On November 6, 2017, at or near 2309 Farringdon Road, Baltimore County, Maryland, the Enterprise, including, among others, Travon WILLIAMSTON carjacked ██████████. ██████████ was tackled and punched before the DEFENDANTS took his gray 2017 Honda Accord and car keys. ██████████ suffered injuries to his foot and neck.

19. On November 6, 2017, at or near 3003 Elizabeth Avenue, Baltimore, Maryland, the Enterprise carjacked ██████████ with a gun and a knife. ██████████ was punched and had weapons pointed at him before the DEFENDANTS took his black 2015 Honda Accord, wallet, and cellular phone.

20. On November 7, 2017, in the 2500 block of Wegworth Avenue, Baltimore City, Maryland, the Enterprise, including, among others, Daquan JOHNSON, carjacked ██████████. ██████████ was punched before the DEFENDANTS took his black 2008 Nissan Altima, wallet, and car keys.

21. On November 7, 2017, in the 600 block of South Monroe, Baltimore, Maryland, the Enterprise, including, among others, Daquan JOHNSON and Travon WILLIAMSTON carjacked ██████████. ██████████ vehicle was struck from behind. When ██████████ exited her car to inspect the damage, she was hugged in a staged apology before the DEFENDANTS took her gray 2014 Honda Accord. On December 21, 2017, Tyheim GRAY was in possession of the key to ██████████ 2014 Honda Accord.

22. On November 9, 2017, in the 6300 block of Green Meadow Parkway, Avenue, Baltimore, Maryland, the Enterprise carjacked ██████████. ██████████ was punched and kicked before the DEFENDANTS took his blue 2017 Hyundai Sonata and wristwatch.

23. On November 10, 2017, in the 3300 block of Falstaff Road, Baltimore, Maryland, the Enterprise, including, among others, Dalante GRAHAM and Daquan JOHNSON, carjacked

██████████. ██████████ was punched in the head before the DEFENDANTS took her black 2016 Toyota Scion.

24. On November 22, 2017, in the 600 block of Wellesley Street, Baltimore, Maryland, the Enterprise carjacked ██████████. ██████████ was punched and kicked before the DEFENDANTS took his beige 2004 Toyota Sienna and cellular phone. ██████████ suffered injuries to his nose and head.

25. On November 24, 2017, at or near 2455 Forest Green Road, Baltimore County, Maryland, the Enterprise, including, among others, Tyheim GRAY, Daquan JOHNSON, and Travon WILLIAMSTON stole ██████████ black 2014 Cadillac SRX. On November 26, 2017, GRAY streamed a video on Facebook showing himself sitting in the same Cadillac and brandishing a handgun.

26. On November 24, 2017, at or near 6320 Greenspring Avenue, Baltimore, Maryland, the Enterprise carjacked ██████████. ██████████ and his passenger, ██████████, had what appeared to be handguns pointed at them. The DEFENDANTS took ██████████ silver 2013 Hyundai, wallet, and cellular phone. The DEFENDANTS also took ██████████ bag and cellular phone.

27. On November 25, 2017, in the 2200 block of North Howard Street, Baltimore, Maryland, the Enterprise, including, among others, Tyheim GRAY, carjacked ██████████. ██████████ was struck in the head with what appeared to be a handgun before the DEFENDANTS took his silver 2014 Honda Accord, wallet, and cellular phone. ██████████ suffered injuries to his ear.

28. On November 25, 2017, in the 2300 block of Hollins Ferry Road, Baltimore, Maryland, the Enterprise, including, among others, Tyheim GRAY, Daquan JOHNSON, and Trayvon WILLIAMSTON, carjacked ██████████. ██████████ vehicle was pinned in by three different vehicles. He was then restrained and hit in the face with what he believed to be a handgun before the DEFENDANTS took his gray 2017 Honda Accord. ██████████ suffered a broken nose and several facial bruises.

29. On November 26, 2017, in the 1700 block of Charles Street, Baltimore, Maryland, the Enterprise, including, among others, Daquan JOHNSON, carjacked ██████████. ██████████ was struck in the face with what he believed to be a handgun before the DEFENDANTS took his gray 2013 Infiniti G37 and phone. Dalante GRAHAM and Moya PITTMAN bailed out of and abandoned this 2013 Infiniti after being chased by police on December 2, 2017.

30. On November 26, 2017, at or near 6414 Elray Drive, Baltimore, Maryland, the Enterprise, including, among others, Dalante GRAHAM carjacked ██████████. ██████████ was tackled before the DEFENDANTS took his black 2017 Nissan. ██████████ suffered injuries to his head and wrist.

31. On November 26, 2017, at or near 6 Brubar Court, Gwynn Oak, Maryland, the Enterprise, including, among others, Dalante GRAHAM and Daquan JOHNSON, carjacked ██████████ as he sat parked with a passenger, ██████████. ██████████ had what appeared to

be a handgun pointed at him before the DEFENDANTS took his gray 2017 Honda Accord. The DEFENDANTS also took [REDACTED] belongings.

32. On November 27, 2017, in the 400 block of North Luzerne Avenue, Baltimore, Maryland, the Enterprise, including, among others, Dalante GRAHAM, Tyheim GRAY, and Trayvon WILLIAMSTON, carjacked [REDACTED] using [REDACTED] Acura that the Enterprise had carjacked just hours before. [REDACTED] had what she believed was a handgun pointed at her before the DEFENDANTS took her black 2012 Acura TL as well as a handgun she had been transporting in the trunk.

33. On November 27, 2017, in the 1200 block of Key Highway, Baltimore, Maryland, the Enterprise, including, among others, Daquan JOHNSON, carjacked [REDACTED] using the handgun that was in [REDACTED] Acura when she was carjacked just hours before as well as [REDACTED] Acura that the Enterprise had carjacked just hours before. [REDACTED] had the handgun pointed at her before the DEFENDANTS took her gray 2016 BMW and cellphone.

34. On November 27, 2017, at or near 2249 Washington Boulevard, Baltimore, Maryland, the Enterprise carjacked [REDACTED] using a handgun. [REDACTED] had the handgun pointed at her before the DEFENDANTS took her gold 2013 Infiniti, wallet, and cellular phone.

35. On November 30, 2017, at or near 2111 Tucker Lane, Gwynn Oak, Maryland, the Enterprise carjacked a delivery driver, [REDACTED], using a handgun as [REDACTED] attempted to make a food delivery. [REDACTED] was struck in the head before the DEFENDANTS took his cellphone and silver 2006 Honda Accord.

36. On December 2, 2017, in the 4400 block of Springdale Avenue, Baltimore, Maryland, the Enterprise attempted to carjack another delivery driver, [REDACTED], using a handgun as [REDACTED] attempted to make a food delivery. The Enterprise used [REDACTED] 2006 Honda that it had carjacked two days prior in this attempted carjacking. [REDACTED] unsuccessfully attempted to wrestle the handgun away before speeding off. As he sped off, the DEFENDANTS attempted to cut [REDACTED] off with [REDACTED] 2006 Honda. [REDACTED] escaped but not before the DEFENDANTS fired three shots at him with [REDACTED] stolen gun, striking his rear windshield.

37. On December 6, 2017, at or near 6930 Marsue Drive, Baltimore, Maryland, the Enterprise, including, among others, Dalante GRAHAM, Moya PITTMAN, and Travon WILLIAMSTON carjacked [REDACTED] using a handgun. [REDACTED] was punched and struck with the handgun before the DEFENDANTS took his black 2017 Honda Accord. [REDACTED] suffered a fractured skull.

38. On December 7, 2017, at or near 1633 Waverly Way, Baltimore, Maryland, the Enterprise, including, among others, Dalante GRAHAM, Tyheim GRAY, and Moya PITTMAN, stole [REDACTED] white 2008 Honda Accord.

COUNT TWO

(PARTICIPATION IN A CRIMINAL GANG)

The Jurors of the State of Maryland for the body of Baltimore County, do on their oath present that, since at least as early as September 2017 through the present day, in Baltimore County and Baltimore City, the Defendant, Daquan JOHNSON, did participate in a criminal gang, the aforementioned Enterprise, knowing that the members of said gang engage in criminal gang activity and knowingly and willfully participated in an underlying crime committed in association with a criminal gang, in violation of the Criminal Law Article, Section 9-804, of the Maryland Code against the peace, government, and dignity of the State.

Note: the background, manner, means, methods, use of violence, and additional overt acts listed in Count 1 above are incorporated by reference herein.
