 - Will every event be double sessions?
 - 1 hour is less daunting for people than something longer
 - Otherwise may lose some active engagement
 - Depends on what will be touched on
 - May be helpful to have presenters drop an outline for what will be presented in that block
 - Questions will direct where actual session goes, especially the first
