 - Will be publicizing shortly
 - Would like to put something out on social media
 - Additionally looking for stories about direct affects from virus
 - Unclear if this event ahs been added to AG website
- September 30th forum?
 - Will need moderator
 - And coordinate with jessica
 - Working on content
 - Should have slides by Friday
 - Will send invite for 4 on Friday
- Less marketing from AG's social media for the 23rd
 - Need to coordinate
- Would be good to ensure schedule laid out is confirmed
 - Some committees have too much currently going on
 - With recommendations, forums, etc.
 - May need to adjust time frame for forums
 - Co-chairs should touch base with other chairs
 - Could cause difficulty in pushing out longer term schedule
 - Check-in to ensure they are on track and okay with schedule
- Marketing should be one week before
 - Ideally a week and two days
- SANE survey
 - Have finalized in both hard and electronic form
 - Audience - providers servicing populations vulnerable to abuse, neglect, exploitation
 - Elderly, disabled, children, immigrant population, etc.
 - Two surveys
 - One to providers - experience during pandemic
 - Asking providers to put out to recipients of their services
 - Totally anonymous, no identifying information
 - What has there experience been
 - Has been a decrease of reports to the providers
 - Anecdotally - not because these incidents have lessened, may be because resources have not remained available or people do not know where to go right now
 - Looking to guide and inform in long-term recommendations
 - More data driven
 - Have a list of providers

- May be able to put together a list of types that we could target
 - not/cannot reach out to children and/or prisoners
 - But will reach out to those providers
 - Looking to have it by November first
 - Anyone over the age of 18
 - Have already sent electronic version to providers on their list
 - Has link to hard copy
 - Hoping we can help reach a broader population
 - Anticipate some could answer hard copy but would likely need postage prepaid
 - Survey monkey vehicle can get up to 1000 surveys
 - Challenge is how to get hard copies out
 - Is there any possibility of funding coming in?
 - Have submitted proposals, have not received a response
 - May hear by the end of September
 - Can send link around
 - Would like, conservatively, 250 hard copies sent
 - Adult protective services will be sending
 - Legal aid will put in local offices
 - MVLS will also receive copies
 - This will likely mean the printed count will need to be much greater
 - Percent return is likely to be a fraction of that
 - Will see if AG print center can help
 - Likely don't have prepaid envelope capabilities
 - Also looking at faith organizations
 - Law enforcement?

 - Will be looking for a distribution model to get out access to benefits resources
