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PREFACE

When I took office as Attorney General of Maryland on December 15, 1966, I immediately became aware of the fact that there had been no supplement to the Index to Official Opinions of the Attorneys General of Maryland since the first index appeared in 1945. An assistant attorney general, or any other interested person, who desired to review the opinions of this office for the years 1945 through 1966 was, therefore, required to examine the index appearing in each separate volume of Opinions of the Attorney General—certainly a most difficult and time consuming task.

In the Spring of 1967, I assigned to Assistant Attorney General George W. Liebmann, of the Baltimore Bar, the considerable task of preparing an index for volumes 31 through 51 of the Opinions of Attorney General, and of including in that volume a citator to all of the opinions appearing in volumes 1 through 51. I am certain that the use of the resulting index will bring about the saving of thousands of research hours annually by members of this staff, and it is my hope that it will be of great assistance to my fellow members of the Bar as they seek to familiarize themselves with the views of this office on the outstanding legal questions of the last half century.

As you will note, this index contains a pocket on the inside back cover for the insertion of supplements. It is our intention to prepare such a supplement every two years and to make those supplements cumulative.

I wish to particularly express my thanks to Mr. Liebmann and to the secretarial personnel of this office who worked with him on this laborious project.
