Body-Worn Camera Footage from Fatal Police-Involved Shooting in Towson Released

BALTIMORE, MD (June 30, 2022) – The Independent Investigations Division of the Office of the Attorney General today released the [body-worn camera footage](#) from the fatal police-involved shooting that occurred on June 4, 2022, in Towson, Maryland. The decedent was identified as 66-year-old Joseph Robert Henry Thompson, of Towson.

The IID will generally release body-worn camera and dashboard camera footage within 14 days of an incident. The release of the body-worn camera footage in this incident was delayed to ensure witness interviews were not compromised by their viewing of external evidence.
