Camera Footage from Fatal Crash Following Attempted Traffic Stop in East Baltimore Released

BALTIMORE, MD (March 2, 2023) – The Independent Investigations Division (IID) of the Maryland Office of the Attorney General today released the [body-worn and CitiWatch camera footage](#) from the fatal crash following an attempted traffic stop on February 8 in East Baltimore. The decedent was previously identified as 54-year-old Alfred Fincher of Baltimore.

The Maryland General Assembly, in Senate Bill 600, passed a law mandating that the Office of the Attorney General (OAG) investigate all police-involved fatalities in the State of Maryland beginning October 1, 2021. These investigations are conducted by the office's Independent Investigations Division, in conjunction with the Maryland State Police. The OAG and Baltimore Police have reached an agreement to allow for the Attorney General's investigation while still allowing Baltimore Police to meet the investigatory obligations of its federal consent decree.
