Decedent and Officers Identified in In-Custody Death Investigation in Baltimore City

BALTIMORE, MD (August 3, 2023) - The Independent Investigations Division of the Maryland Office of the Attorney General has identified the decedent and involved officers in the in-custody death that occurred on July 25, 2023, in Baltimore City.

The decedent has been identified as 29-year-old Trea Ellinger of Glen Burnie, Maryland.

The involved Maryland Transit Administration Police officers have been identified as Officer Michelle Price, an 8-year veteran; Officer Daitione Garnett, a 6-year veteran; Officer Perry Talbert, a 5-year veteran; Officer Andre Watson, a 5-year veteran; and Officer Ralph Massimei, a 5-year veteran.

The involved Baltimore Police officers have been identified as Officer Sharrod Mobley, a 3-year veteran, and Officer Ryan Barnes-Klipa who has been with the department for one year.
