Fatal Officer-Involved Shooting in Baltimore County Under Investigation

BALTIMORE, MD (November 25, 2023) – The Independent Investigations Division (IID) of the Maryland Office of the Attorney General is investigating a fatal officer-involved shooting that occurred in Parkville, in Baltimore County, Maryland, late Friday night.

On November 24, 2023, at approximately 11:33 p.m., officers with the Baltimore County Police Department responded to a residence located in the 2700 block of Maple Avenue for a reported domestic disturbance.

An initial review of evidence shows that as the first responding officer approached the residence, shots were heard from inside the home as well as the sound of a woman screaming. As officers approached, an adult man opened the front door of the residence and fired a weapon at the officers. During the incident, three officers discharged their weapons.

The adult man who fired at the officers was pronounced dead at the scene. A search of the residence also revealed a deceased adult woman. A handgun was recovered next to the adult man.

The IID will generally release the name of the decedent and discharging officers within two business days of the incident, although that period may be extended if there is a specific reason to believe that an officer's safety is at risk.

Officers on scene were equipped with body-worn cameras, which recorded the incident. The IID will generally release the footage within 20 business days of an incident. There may be situations where more than 20 days is necessary, including

if investigators need more time to complete witness interviews, if there are technical delays caused by the need to shield the identities of civilian witnesses, or to allow family members to view the video before it is released to the public.
