Investigation Update and Decedent and Officers Identified in In-Custody Death Investigation in Largo

BALTIMORE, MD (February 21, 2024) – The Independent Investigations Division (IID) of the Maryland Office of the Attorney General has identified the decedent and officers involved in the in-custody death that occurred on February 16, 2024, in Largo, Maryland.

In addition, based on its preliminary investigation, the IID has determined that a police officer with the Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission (WSSC) Police Department was present and assisted other officers on scene.

The decedent has been identified as 61-year-old Joseph Holmes of Clinton, Maryland.

The involved Prince George's County Police officers have been identified as Corporal Alyssa Tomaselli, an 11-year veteran; Corporal Mark Price, a 9-year veteran; and Officer Marvin Marks who has been with the department for two years and has a total of 30 years of law enforcement experience. All officers are assigned to the Bureau of Patrol.

The involved WSSC Police Department officer has been identified as Officer Andre Brooks, a 7-year veteran who has a total of 34 years of law enforcement experience.
