## Body-Worn and Dashboard Camera Footage from Fatal Crash in Carroll County Released

**BALTIMORE, MD (May 23, 2024)** – The Independent Investigations Division (IID) of the Maryland Office of the Attorney General today released [body-worn and dashboard camera footage](#) of the fatal crash following an attempted traffic stop by a Carroll County Sheriff's Deputy, on April 20, 2024, in Eldersburg, in Carroll County.

The decedent was previously identified as 22-year-old Kayla Rodriguez-Garcia of Randallstown, Maryland.

The IID will generally release body-worn camera and dashboard camera footage within 20 business days of an incident. The release of camera footage in this incident was delayed to allow the decedent's family an opportunity to view the video before it was released to the public.
