Body-Worn Camera Footage from Montgomery County Police Officer-Involved Fatal Shooting Released

BALTIMORE, MD (July 31, 2024) – The Independent Investigations Division (IID) of the Maryland Office of the Attorney General today released the body-worn camera footage from the Montgomery County Police Department's Officer-Involved Fatal Shooting that occurred on May 30, 2024, in Fairland, Maryland.

The decedent was previously identified as 28-year-old Bishop Jones-Daniel of Forestville, Maryland. However, new information has now determined that Mr. Jones-Daniel was a resident of Clinton, Maryland.

The IID will generally release body-worn camera and dashboard camera footage within 20 business days of an incident. The release of body-worn camera footage in this incident was delayed to allow additional time to conduct witness interviews.
