Decedent and Officers Identified in Fatal Shooting in Howard County

BALTIMORE, MD (December 4, 2024) – The Independent Investigations Division (IID) of the Maryland Office of the Attorney General has identified the decedent, and the Howard County Officers involved in the fatal shooting that occurred on Saturday, November 30, 2024, in Laurel, Howard County, Maryland.

The decedent has been identified as 29-year-old Tyree Winslow of College Park, Maryland.

The involved officers are both with the Howard County Police Department and are identified as Police Officer First Class (PFC) Christopher Weir, a 14-year veteran, and PFC Joseph Debronzio, a 15-year veteran. Both officers are assigned to the Field Operations Division.
