 - a. Need to be spent by end of year
 - b. Tax sales
 - i. Public outreach for tax sales
 - 1. Intervening and getting connected with homeowners as soon as possible, prior to tax sales, is crucial
 - ii. Consider affected population: Black windowed women
 - iii. Mapping areas that have been most affected by tax sales and target efforts there
 - 1. Hold public events; provide public information
 - 2. Mailing likely not to be effective
 - c. Foreclosures
 - i. Hotline
 - ii. Self-help centers
 - d. Must consider the parallels between tax sales and foreclosures

- e. Housing counseling
 - i. Consider 2010 funding requests
 - ii. Educating counselors when should people refer to a lawyer
- f. Tie information to essential services to communicate with the public
 - i. Food assistance

 - i. Difficulties with online portals
 - ii. Fund existing homeowner programs
