- Town Hall Week of August 24
  - Specifically geared towards housing
  - Generally thinking weekdays
    - People are often more settled by Wednesday
    - **8/26**
    - Tend to think evenings would be able to get to people who are working
    - Possibility to do 2 sessions 2pm and potentially later
      - Could give a gauge of which attracts more viewership
  - Need speakers from housing committee
  - Need to promote
    - Legal aid's director of marketing can help with some promotion
  - Need to determine platform and format
    - Previous discussion surrounding 40min presentation, 15-20min q&a
    - Facebook may help with turnaround, same with youtube
      - Allowable to use attorney general's youtube channel?
      - Require certain number of subscribers to livestream on youtube
      - Can offer attorney general's account for facebook
      - Uncomfortable to ask people to sign up for facebook in order to participate would not be able to participate in live chat
        - Not out of question, but more difficult
      - Could use zoom/teams/etc.
        - Fritz Schantz
        - Zoom can stream through facebook and webpage
        - OAG employees cannot have zoom on work computers
      - Still in discussions with streamyard to have premium account

- Could people sign-up/submit questions in advance?
- Cisco web meetings do not require signup
  - Can use to meet everyone except presenters while allowing chat
- Could try facebook at 2:00 and another in the evening (6:00)
- Chijioke will follow-up with cisco info
- Libraries
  - People who register will get a link the day before with access info
  - Promote registration, not direct link
- Will need to sort out interpreter v. close-captioning for hearing events
  - Phone service for hard of hearing will soon be offered at low/no cost
    - Not by next week or two but for later town halls
- What about those without the technological abilities?
  - Are libraries open to those without access?
    - Some counties have open libraries, others do not
    - Most are still closed to the public
- Would it be possible to stream through public television
  - Unsure if there was a live-streaming capability or if they needed to have a recorded message
- Consider developing relationship with maryland municipal league
  - Municipalities often have public access streaming
- Next steps
  - Confirm presenters are available
  - Webex would have a presenter and another person interacting with questions
    - Limit is 150
    - Potential need to reimburse to use platform
    - Check legal aid can make their system work
  - Library has some use of crowdcast
  - Judiciary has zoom for government which has been approved
- We could use general point of contact to technical pieces
- Date September/October

    - Tuesday-Thursday are most popular days
    - Wednesday seems general preferred
